### **Scrap Iron Board Holds Fall Meeting**

Our Scrap Iron Bylaws specify an end of year and a start of the year meeting of the Scrap Iron Board of Directors. The SI Board is made up of one voting member per Club team. The Board makes decisions on major matters such as, member dues, team budgets, and any changes to Club Bylaws or policies. The Board also elects the seven member Executive Committee which makes most of the smaller decisions. The Board met on Saturday, November 29<sup>th</sup> and made the following decisions:

<u>New Teams</u> – For the first time in several years, there are no additional teams requesting to join the Scrap Iron Softball Club. There were a few moves among existing teams. The 55 Rockies will play as a 60s team in 2015, and the 65 Reds have moved to the 70s division. The 65 Classics have moved up to AAA for 2015, and they are having a contest to determine a new name.

<u>Policy Changes</u> - Our Player Dues Policy was changed. Previously, member dues for players 74 and older were half of the regular member dues. This was changed to 75 and older during the dues paying year. This change reflects the end of SSUSA's exception where players 74 years old were able to play on a 75s team.

Our Fill-in Player Policy was changed for players who are not Club members. A player who is <u>not a member</u> of the Scrap Iron Softball Club may play no more than one (1) tournament per year with Scrap Iron teams. The full membership fee is required if he is to play any additional tournaments in that year.

<u>Dues Decision</u> – It appears that the Club will end the year with an approximate loss of \$1,300. This decrease is mostly attributable to the King Soopers and Safeway Gift Card Program producing less revenue than anticipated. While we will net nearly \$6,000 in 2014 from the gift cards, only a small fraction of our members are participating actively. Thirty regular users have generated most of the income. A doubling or tripling of active participants would help our team budgets immensely. Ten of our 17 teams could have used a larger budget in 2014, and it is likely that tournament registrations will increase slightly for 2015. Team budgets will be approved at the February 7, 2015 Board meeting after we have a clear picture of fund raising. Ways to increase income by \$5,000 were discussed. The approach chosen was a \$20 dues increase where every member will receive a \$10 grocery gift card. The card is as good as cash and anyone who prefers to not continue using it can make a purchase and then discard the card. Every member will have a chance to try the card and see how painless it is to raise money for the Club. We hope that this approach will add 20-40 regular users to the program.

Dues for 2015 are \$195 for regular members and \$102.50 for members 75 and older in 2015. Dues for members 75 and older are slightly more than half due to the \$10 benefit returned.

<u>Hall of Fame (HOF) Committee</u> – The HOF Committee has three new members. The Boards elected Mark Haupt, Arn Richardson, and Alan Wiechmann to join former members, Greg Broeckelman, Mike Massong, and Art Graebe. Many thanks to Bob Wiltgen, Arlen Amundson, and Bert Hertzke for years of service on this committee.

<u>Executive Committee</u> – Five of the seven 2014 Executive Committee members were willing to continue in their positions. Alan Wiechmann and Bill Fleming asked to step down from the committee. Andy Shapiro was nominated as President, and Ron Howard as a new At Large member. *The Board approved the following members for the 2015 Executive Committee:*
