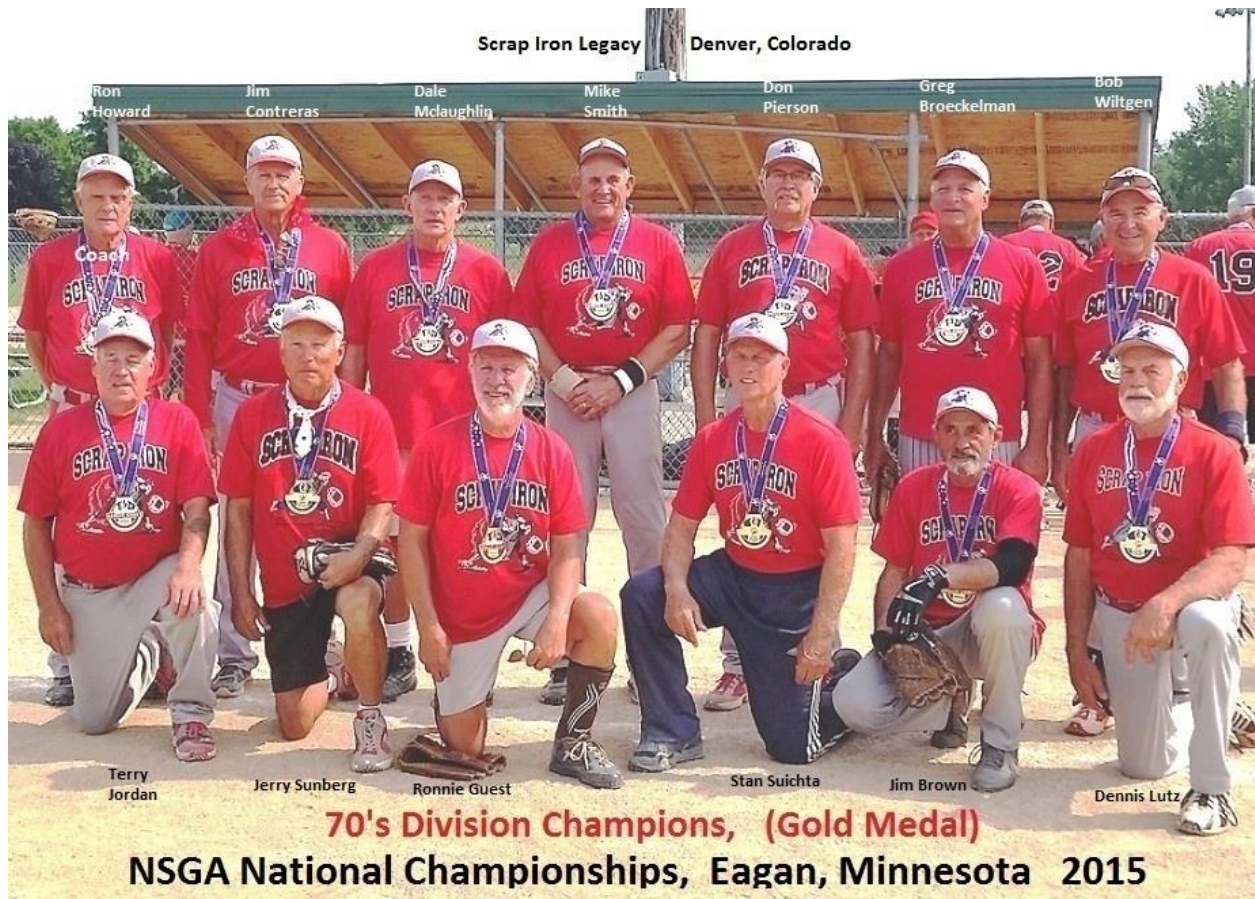


National Senior Softball Hall of Fame Selectee, Greg Broeckelman
